Requirements for State and/or Lake Record Freshwater Fish

- Fish must be caught from a private pond within the State of Alabama or from public waters under Alabama's Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries jurisdiction.
- 2. Fish must be caught by legal angling methods either on pole and line, or rod and reel.
- 3. Weighing of the fish must be witnessed by two persons other than the angler.
- 4. Fish must be weighed in an unfrozen state, on scales that have been checked and certified for accuracy by government agencies or other qualified and accredited organizations within the twelve (12) months prior to the catch.
- 5. Any weights that fall between two graduations will be rounded down to the lower of the two.
- 6. Fish weighed only on a body of water will not be considered.
- 7. To replace a record for a fish weighing less than 25 pounds, the replacement weight must weigh at least two (2) ounces more that the existing record. To replace a record for a fish weighing 25 pounds or more, the replacement weight must be at least 0.5 % (0.005) more than the existing record. Examples: At 50 pounds, the additional weight required would be four (4) ounces; at 100 pounds the additional weight required would be eight (8) ounces.
- 8. Any catch that matches the weight of an existing record or exceeds the weight by less than the amount required to defeat the record will be considered a tie. No fish weighing less than the original record will be considered.
- 9. The fish must meet the minimum size requirements listed in Table 2 (on back), which corresponds with Table 1 (below).

10. The fish must be available in fresh or frozen state to verify the correct species and weight by a fisheries biologist of the Alabama Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries or a Certified Fisheries Scientist approved by the Chief of Fisheries. Fish may be taken to any of the district fisheries offices which are located in Tanner (Dist. I), Eastaboga (Dist. II), Northport (Dist. III), Enterprise (Dist. IV), and Spanish Fort (Dist. V).

- 11. Applicant must posses a valid Alabama fishing license at time application is submitted (persons under the age of 16 and Alabama residents 65 years of age or older are exempt).
- 12. Application must be **fully completed**, notarized, and submitted on an official application form within three (3) months of the catch.
- 13. Fish caught prior to January 1, 2007, may be submitted for Lake Record consideration if 1) all other requirements are met, or 2) the fish is currently recognized by the International Game Fish Association.
- 14. Polygraph tests will be randomly administered to Lake Record and State Record applicants and their catches may be disallowed if questions arise regarding the legitimacy of the catch.
- 15. Final judgment relating to the legitimacy of each entry will be the responsibility of the Chief of Fisheries for the Alabama Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries.
- 16. Applications for State Record fish are exempt from Requirements No. 9 and No. 13.

Application Procedures

- Application must include a photograph showing side view of the fish with a ruler or yardstick clearly visible beside the fish for use as a reference to its length. Graduations on the ruler must also be visible.
- 2. Application should include a second photograph of the angler with the fish to be included on the Department's website.
- 3. A photocopy of the angler's fishing license must be included with the application.
- 4. Application must be <u>fully completed</u>, <u>notarized</u>, and returned to the address below.
